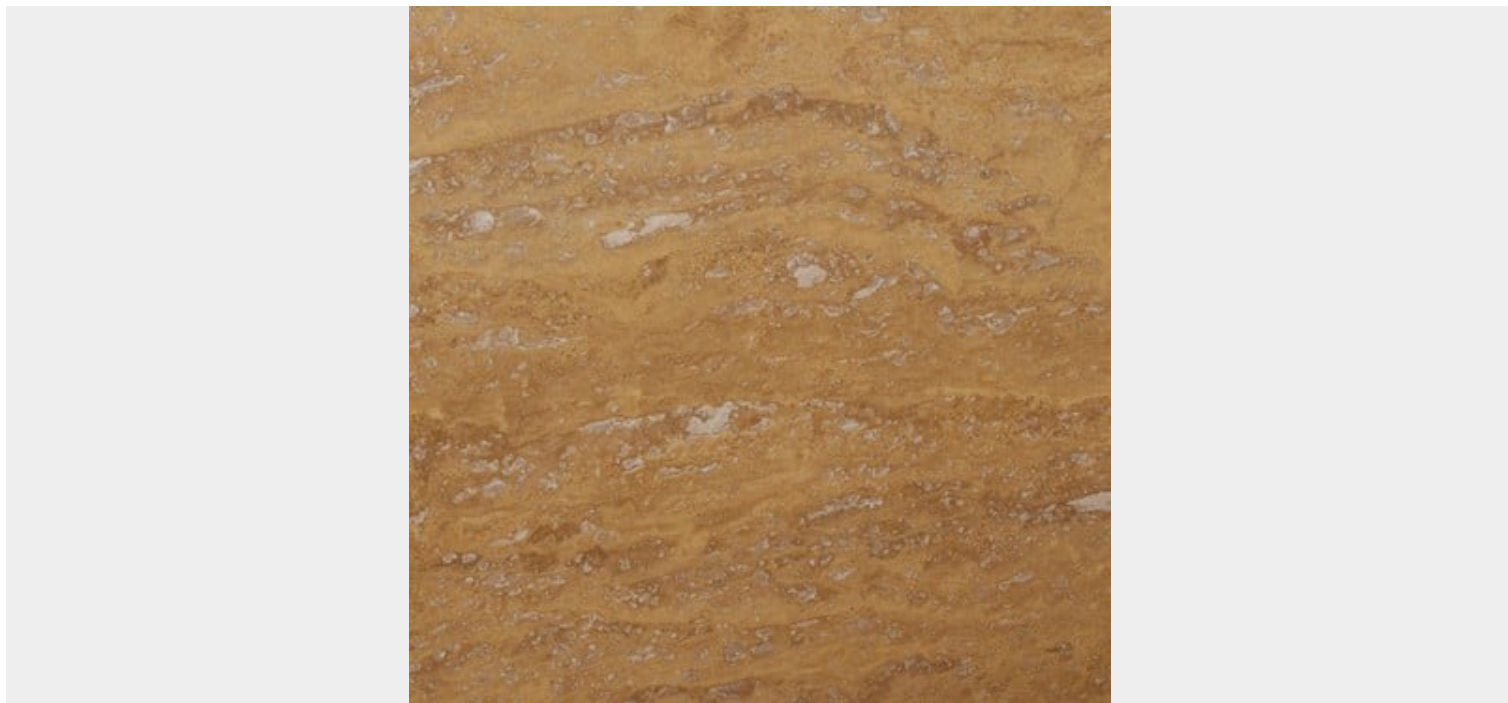


TRAVERTINE (CATEGORY) PERSIAN YELLOW TYPE

PERSIAN YELLOW TRAVERTINE is a marble of Iranian origin with a characteristic bright yellow color.

It is a rather valuable material that achieves high-level results especially with the polished, brushed and sandblasted finishes.

A wet effect is suggested that enhances the bright color of the material.

PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

Travertines (category)

Since ancient Romans, TRAVERTINE is one of the most common marble used to build up monuments , antique and modern housing. Some examples are the Colosseum and the most famous monuments of ancient Rome.

TRAVERTINE is recognizable by typical holes on its surface both in vein cutting (frequently used) and in cross cutting. These holes can be left "open" or they can be plastered by concrete (also colored) and by synthetic resin (also trasparente).

In scientific publishing it is described as a fine-grained chalky rock shaped by Calcium Carbonate fast precipitation present in an ancient pond.

TRAVERTINE could be kneaded in different manners so it is suitable for both indoor and outdoor uses

TRAVERTINE's colors depends on oxides that absorbed during its formation (it happens regularly thanks to its permeable and porous structure). Natural shading varies from off white to nutmeg, and from yellow to red hues.
